

### Benite Adoremus!

Today, we begin a new liturgical year (Cycle-C Year-II). This Advent, while professing our faith in the glorious coming of the Lord at the end of time, we do not sing the Gloria, so that we may be reminded of our anticipation for the coming of the Messiah. And while we prepare four Sundays to celebrate the wonder of Christmas, we are reminded of Christ coming into our lives through the sacraments of the church. We must ask ourselves how many times we offended Him and his honor by not adequately preparing ourselves to receive Him, how we became proud of even daring to approach Him while not in the state of grace - by not going to confession to admit our faults, by being proud in thinking that we are not in need of forgiveness, by thinking that we can approach and receive Him in the Eucharist as if we are only eating a piece of bread, and by not recognizing the humanity of Jesus in our neighbor. "Let us worship well!"

The beginning of liturgical "Year C" relies upon guidance from the Gospel of St. Luke, a collection of orderly accounts of eyewitnesses of Jesus, and of the earliest apostles and disciples of Jesus. Aside from being witnesses in the spirit, St. Luke wanted us to conserve and not just to observe the teachings of the "Apostles and The Master." As such, we must be ready to be witnesses and inheritors of such a treasure more precious than gold. Let us light our vigil lamps and candles as we await the coming of the Lord – who is with us, the Emmanuel. Maranatha! Come Lord! Fr. Norlito
