



The first Desert Father was Paul of Thebes, (Left Photo) and the most well known was Anthony the Great, (Top Photo) who moved to the desert in AD 270-271 and became known as both the father and founder of desert monasticism. By the time Anthony had died in AD 356, thousands of monks and nuns had been drawn to living in the desert following Anthony's example, leading his biographer, Athanasius of Alexandria, to write that "the desert had become a city. 

Venerable Orsola Benincasa

Today is the death anniversary of the Ven. Orsola Benincasa. She was the founder of the Theatine Sisters of the Immaculate Conception. She was a mystic. She once had a vision which compelled her to ask the Pope to reform the Church. She also had a vision of Mary and the infant Jesus the origin of the Blue Scapular of the Immaculate Conception. The Blue Scapular is one of the 18 scapulars approved by the Vatican.



# Marian Icons Attributed to St. Luke

Today is the feast of St. Luke the Evangelist. Tradition says that he was a painter. There are four ancient Marian icons which are believed to have been "written" by him. The icon of the Mother of Perpetual Help (enshrined in Rome), the icon of Our Lady of Vladimir (enshrined in Moscow, Russia), the icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa (enshrined in Poland), and the icon of Salus Populi Romani (enshrined in Rome).

# Tria Haec: Caritas (Charity) Why Forgiveness is Painful

Those who seek mercy will find it, those who have no humility will not find reward. The greatest charity towards oneself is to ask forgiveness. It takes great humility to admit once faults and ask

for forgiveness. Admitting faults and even saying apologies takes a lot of energy, it is like dying to oneself. Often, our pride and ego can get the best of us. What prevent us form admitting our transgressions is indeed our pride, because we do not want to admit our weakness, and asking or giving forgiveness can be appear to us as a sign of weakness and vulnerability. A feeling that if we show such weakness, our weakness can be used against us. Therefore, the practice Virtue of Charity is the hardest of all the three theological virtues. It is better to give what is surplus instead of a part of ourselves. Giving what is abundant in us cannot be considered as an act of charity, its just a practice of unloading what we do not need, but charity is giving oneself, allowing oneself to have a vacant space in us, and even emptying out.
