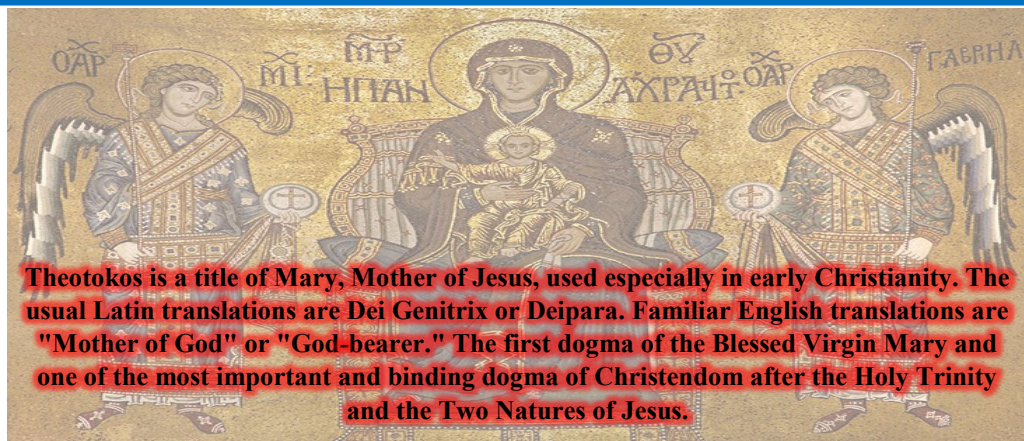


## Mission Statement:

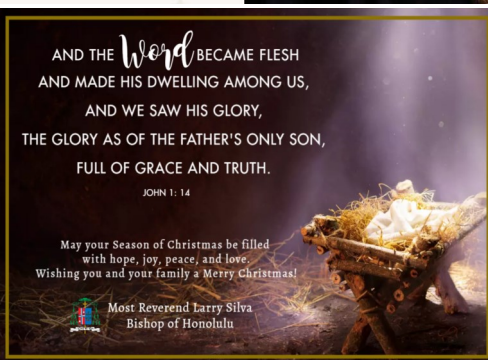
